- The Board first considered approval of the minutes of the Board's March 12, 2020, meeting. Director Jorjorian-Raynal made a motion to approve the minutes. Director Esparza seconded the motion, which the Board passed unanimously.
- As its next item of business, the Board considered the General Manager's and 2. Operator's Reports. Ms. González presented a report on the status of development in the District and other districts.
